COMPANY TRAINING COMMITTEE (CTC) GRANT

The CTC Grant supports entities that have formed CTCs to implement transformation plans aimed at improving worker and business outcomes, with funding support of **up to 70%** of the qualifying cost related to the transformation or training tied to CTC Grant transformation projects that need to achieve:

- **Enterprise transformation:** Enhance business capabilities, innovation and/or productivity; and
- **Workforce transformation:** Better career prospects and better wages for Singapore Citizens/PRs through efforts such as job redesign

Entities legally registered or incorporated in Singapore i.e. companies, societies, non-profit organisations such as charities and social service agencies are welcome to apply, with the following steps:

- Engage UWEEI to form a CTC
- Develop transformation plan in discussion with the CTC showing how it leads to better worker and business outcomes
- UWEEI will guide you through the project implementation
